

What kind of access will I have to the Eisenhower Fellows?

As an EF youth leader, you will have exposure and access to a global network of accomplished professional leaders representing all sectors and from every region of the world. Over time we hope a vibrant global network of the next generation of young leaders will be created, with a potential for stand-alone global events aimed specifically at youth. How does the mentorship component work?

You will be assigned a mentor from the EF network. This could be someone from your own country or from another, but it will be someone that EF has carefully matched you with based on your interests and goals. Your EF mentor will commit to working with you for one year post-conference. You will be introduced virtually before the conference begins, and will be responsible for maintaining good communication with your mentor.

What will happen at the conference?

You will participate in the Eisenhower Fellowships Future of Work conference from September 14-17, 2017 in Málaga, Spain. You will attend a one-day leadership workshop led by Eisenhower staff and Fellows and then join the Future of Work conference. A few selected youth leaders will participate in a moderated panel discussion about expectations for jobs and employment over the next generation with Eisenhower Fellows. Tell me more about the project component.

You will submit a project outline as part of your application. During the conference, you will have an opportunity to discuss your project with conference participants. One youth leader (or team of 2 or more youth leaders) will be recognized and supported to advance this project beyond the planning stages.

What will happen post-initiative?

You will be expected to share what you have learned with your university or youth community and beyond, and commit to mentoring someone younger than yourself for at least one year post-conference. Your EF mentor will guide and monitor you during this period.
