Eisenhower Fellowships identifies, empowers and connects innovative leaders through a transformative international experience and lifelong engagement in a global network of more than 2,400 dynamic change agents from 115 countries, committed to creating a world more peaceful, prosperous and just.

The **Eisenhower Global Scholars Program** will send four outstanding American university graduates abroad for the 2020-2021 academic year to prestigious universities in Europe for intensive study and hands-on work experience in two major areas:

- **Master of Public Policy at the Blavatnik School of Government at the University of Oxford**
- **Master in International Relations at the IE School of Global & Public Affairs in Madrid**

Each Eisenhower Scholar will spend a full academic year of postgraduate study leading to a Master's Degree at either **the University of Oxford or IE University in Madrid**. All courses are offered in English.

During their academic year of study, or after the school year is completed, the Scholars will travel for two weeks to a few cities in Europe to meet with Eisenhower Fellows. Eisenhower Scholars will experience the **lifelong connection to a network of like-minded leaders**. The Scholars will be offered optional summer internships in collaboration with the EF Global Network.

Preferred candidates will be between 20 and 30 years old and will have:

- a track record of achievement, including a strong academic undergraduate record and community involvement
- demonstrated leadership potential
- a concrete project proposal that this international post-graduate study will advance
