Eisenhower Fellowships identifies, empowers and connects innovative leaders through a transformative international experience and lifelong engagement in a global network of more than 2,600 dynamic change agents from 118 countries, committed to creating a world more peaceful, prosperous and just.

The Eisenhower Global Scholars Program will send four outstanding American university graduates abroad for the 2026-2027 academic year to prestigious universities in Europe for intensive study and hands-on work experience in two major areas:

- Master of Public Policy at the Blavatnik School of Government at the University of Oxford
- Master in International Relations at the IE School of Global & Public Affairs in Madrid

Each Eisenhower Scholar will spend a full academic year of postgraduate study leading to a Master's Degree at either the University of Oxford or IE University in Madrid. Eisenhower Fellowships covers all major expenses. All courses are offered in English.

During their academic year of study, or after the school year is completed, the Scholars will meet with Eisenhower Fellows. Eisenhower Global Scholars will experience the lifelong connection to a network of like-minded leaders. The Scholars may be offered optional summer internships in collaboration with the EF Global Network.

Candidates must be U.S. citizens or legal permanent residents preferably between 20 and 30 years old and will have:

- a track record of achievement, including a strong academic undergraduate record and community involvement
- demonstrated leadership potential
- a concrete project proposal that this international post-graduate study will advance
